Spring is here and launching your boat for the season is just one beautiful spring day away. Here are some pre-season housekeeping tidbits to think about that can afford you that extra measure of protection and minimize loss.



Be sure to conduct a regular maintenance checkup: gas lines, spark plugs, float switches (i.e. bilge pumps), check all thru-hulls and water lines. Be sure to reconnect any items that were disconnected for winter maintenance and check the on board fire extinguisher to ensure that it has an up to date safety inspection. Make sure that all communication and navigation equipment is in proper working order and that all flotation devices and flares are up to code.
